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Sanapiratti to implement solid waste management system

In a bid to infuse better civic sense among the residents of Sanapiratti panchayat in Karur, an effective solid waste management concept in the local body limits, an awareness programme was launched in Sanapiratti on Thursday.

Society for Education, Environment and Development (SEED), a voluntary organization, has been assisting the panchayat in implementing the solid waste management programme.

Sanapiratti panchayat president P.Elangovan presiding over the awareness campaign said the panchayat is clean, and stressed that effective steps need to be taken to strengthen the system in the panchayat, which is adjacent to the urban area.

The panchayat, on an average, generated 15 tonnes of solid waste a day and the enormity of the waste can be gauged well, he pointed out. The panchayat president solicited public cooperation for the implementation of the scheme. SEED president D.Rajendran detailed the activities of the organisation and said that degradation is detrimental, particularly to the marginalised sections of society as they are exposed to health hazards, he said. Mr.Rajendran said that SEED has prepared a detailed project report to set up a solid waste management system in the Sanapiratti panchayat for the benefit of its residents.

Speakers stressed the need to segregate biodegradable and non-biodegradable wastes at source itself, for an effective solid waste management system. After a detailed study the route map for using rickshaws and tractors used for collecting garbage has been finalised, Mr. Rajendran added.

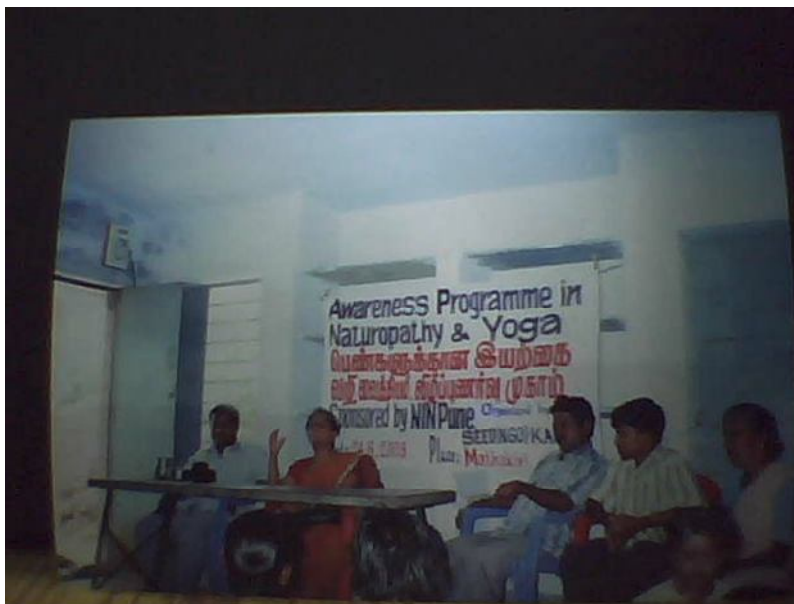
